ORDINANCE NO. 1084

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, AMENDING ARTICLE 4, OF THE FREDERICK MUNICIPAL CODE, IMPOSING ACADEMIC RESTRICTIONS ON FREDERICK HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Frederick finds it necessary to amend the Town of Frederick Municipal Code, 1992, to make the Code consistent with Town practices, repeal inapplicable and remnant provisions, and to clarify and improve public understanding of Town procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Town created an academic scholarship program for graduates of Frederick High School under Ordinance 949 (2008), administered through the Scholarship Commission and annual awards granted by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined it is in the best interests of the residents of the Town to adjust the university GPA requirement for Frederick High School Scholarship recipients to match the high school GPA required to qualify for the program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Frederick, Weld County, Colorado, that:

Section 1. Section 4-166(b) of the *Frederick Municipal Code, 1992, as amended*, is hereby repealed in its entirely and reenacted to read as follows:

Sec. 4-166. Restrictions.

- "(b) To remain eligible for funding, the student must achieve at least a 3.0 grade point average for each academic year."
- **Section 2.** This ordinance shall apply to all current scholarship program participants.
- **Section 3. Effective Date**. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.
- **Section 4. Severability.** If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid.
- **Section 5.** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

Section 6. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and make not less than one copy of the adopted Code available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
