

**TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO  
ORDINANCE NO. 1110**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO,  
ESTABLISHING THE PARK FUND AND AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE  
IV OF THE *FREDERICK MUNICIPAL CODE*.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Frederick by Ordinance No. 146, established the Park Fund for the purpose of the purchase of lands for additional parks and for the improvement of existing and new parks in the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the Board of Trustees that the existing Park Improvement Fund is to be combined in the "Park Fund"; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to accomplish the above stated purpose of creating a unified Park Fund, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is appropriate to repeal Sec. 4-53, of the *Frederick Municipal Code* and reenact said Sec. 4-53 as provided below;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 4-53 of the *Frederick Municipal Code* is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read as follows:

**"Sec. 4-53. Park Fund established.**

All activities heretofore or hereafter conducted by the Town for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of the Town with public parks and recreational opportunities, including but not limited to the purchase and development of land for parks and recreation purposes, the maintenance and operation of public park and recreation facilities and activities, the ownership and operation of the Bella Rosa Golf Course and Milavec Lake, and the ownership and operation of similar existing or future recreational facilities or activities shall be provided by the Park Fund.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law as of January 1, 2013.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid.

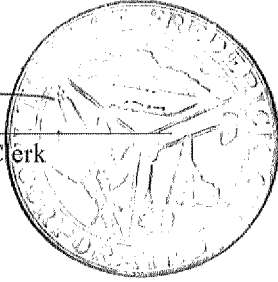
**Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances or resolutions and motions of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Frederick or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance, resolution or motion, nor revive any ordinance, resolution or motion thereby.


