

**TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 1130**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO,
REVISING CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE V, SECTION 7-113 OF THE
FREDERICK MUNICIPAL CODE, ENTITLED "DOG LEASH
REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS."**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determines that it is appropriate to authorize a person charged with a violation of Section 7-113, "Dog leash required; exceptions," Frederick Municipal Code, to enter a guilty plea to the charge by mail, pay the fine established by the Court for such violation, pay the court surcharge, avoiding the necessity to appear in court; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that the enactment of this ordinance is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the town.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
FREDERICK, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Chapter 7, Article V, Section 7-113 of the Frederick Municipal Code is hereby amended with the addition of a new subparagraph to read as follows:

Sec. 7-113. Dog leash required; exceptions.

(e) At the discretion of the charging officer, a person charged with violation of this section for the first time, or second time within a three year period, where there are no more than two counts of violation, may enter a guilty plea by mail by signature on the advisement form provided, full payment of the fine established by the court for such offense, and payment of the court surcharge. Only persons holding current dog license(s) issued by the Frederick Police Department (either at the time of the violation or having purchased the dog license prior to entry of the guilty plea by mail) shall be eligible for the early pay option.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.


Section 3. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid.

Section 4: Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the


repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
