TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO ORDINANCE NO. <u>1143</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE VI, SECTION 4-96 AND CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE I, SECTION 6-1 OF THE *FREDERICK MUNICIPAL CODE* WITH RESPECT TO BUSINESS LICENSES

WHEREAS, THE Board of Trustees upon the recommendation of the Town Clerk, finds it in the best interests of the community to amend the Licenses provision under the Sales and Use Tax Article of the Revenue and Finance Chapter of the Frederick Municipal Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 4, Article VI, Section 4-96 (a) and (b) of the *Frederick Municipal Code* is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read as follows:

"Sec. 4-96. Licenses.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the business of selling tangible personal property at retail, or to furnish certain services as herein specified, without first having obtained a license therefor, which license shall be granted and issued by the Town Clerk pursuant to Chapter 6, Article I as may be amended from time to time.
- (b) In case business is transacted at two (2) or more separate places by one (1) person, a separate license for each place of business shall be required.
- (c) Each license shall be numbered and shall show the name, residence, place and character of business of the licensee, and shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the place of business for which it is issued. No license shall be transferable. (Ord. 272 §6, 1986)
- Section 2. Chapter 6, Article I, Section 6-1 of the *Frederick Municipal Code* is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.1 Requirements.

Whenever any person, firm or corporation engages in the operation or conduct of any business or establishment, or in doing business or engaging in activity for profit, as designated and set out herein, such person, firm or corporation so engaged or occupied shall be subject to the requirements of this Chapter.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.

Section 4. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid.

Section 5. **Repealer.** All ordinances or resolutions and motions of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Frederick or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance, resolution or motion, nor revive any ordinance, resolution or motion thereby.
