

**TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 1151**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO,
ESTABLISHING A FUND FOR THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION
COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, W. Sean Scott, resident of the Town of Frederick and a current member of the Historic Preservation Commission, has authored a book entitled Around Frederick about the history of the Town of Frederick, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, W. Sean Scott has offered and the Town has accepted the assignment of his royalty interests from the sale of the book.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. There is hereby established a Historic Preservation Commission Fund for the purpose of historic preservation projects and such other related projects as may be deemed appropriate.

Section 2. Funding for this Historic Preservation Commission Fund shall come from royalties assigned to it from the sale of the book entitled Around Frederick and such other funds as may be donated to it from time to time.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees acting on the recommendation of the Historic Preservation Commission shall authorize expenditures from the fund consistent with the purpose of historic preservation projects and such other related projects as may be deemed appropriate

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.

Section 5. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid.

Section 6. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions and motions of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Frederick or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such

ordinance, resolution or motion, nor revive any ordinance, resolution or motion thereby.
