RESOLUTION NO. 17-R-10**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, AMENDING THE ADOPTED
2017 BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF FREDERICK MAKING
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF MONEY TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL
EXPENDITURES FROM THE GENERAL FUND**

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Frederick received a recommendation from Town Staff to revise the 2017 spending plan for the funds listed, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Frederick Police Department received a grant for critical training equipment, that was not budgeted for in the 2017 budget; and

WHEREAS, the grant is sufficient to purchase of the training equipment without the allocation of any additional funds; and

WHEREAS, in order to pay for the cost of critical training equipment it is necessary to amend the 2017 budget to provide for the unanticipated revenue and corresponding expense; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to CRS §29-1-109(2) the Town of Frederick is authorized by law to provide for changes to the budget and appropriations to the various funds during the budget year through amendments to the budget and supplemental appropriations adopted by resolution or ordinance setting forth in full the source and amount of such revenues, the purpose for which such revenues are being budgeted and appropriated, and the fund or spending agency which shall make such supplemental expenditures, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Board agrees to make supplemental appropriated expenditures for the 2017 budget, insuring the budget will be in balance and that authorized budgeted expenditures are amended, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The 2017 Budget for the Town of Frederick is hereby amended to provide an increase in the appropriated expenditures as follows:


- a. General Fund \$20,890 Police Capital Equipment

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


Section 3. Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.

Section 4. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution, make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
