## TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 17-R-62

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF COLORADO ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the Town has agreed to develop and construct a 6,450' long by 8' wide ADA pathway with signal crossings from three neighborhoods to the Thunder Valley K-8 School;

WHEREAS, such work will specifically benefit the State of Colorado and the Town of Frederick; and

WHEREAS, such work is part of the Safe Routes to School Program where grant funding through the State contributes 80% of the funds and the applicant (Town of Frederick) contributes 20%.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Frederick, Colorado, that:

- Section 1. The Town Manager is authorized to execute the attached state of Colorado Intergovernmental Agreement in which the State of Colorado agrees to pay the Town of Frederick to develop and construct a 6,450' long by 8' wide ADA pathway with signal crossings from three neighborhoods to the Thunder Valley K-8 School.
- Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
- Section 3. Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- Section 4. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
