A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FREDERICK, COLORADO, APPROVING THE MASTER PLAN FOR ART IN PUBLIC PLACES

WHEREAS, the Frederick Arts Commission has prepared a Master Plan for Art in Public Places through a partnership with Department of Local Affairs and Colorado Center for Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Master Plan is to strengthen Frederick's identity by reinforcing connectivity between neighborhoods, parks, and community spaces. In addition, the plan will provide a framework for decision making regarding Art in Public Places.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Frederick, Colorado, that:

- Section 1. The Master Plan for Art in Public Places is approved.
- Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
- Section 3. Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- Section 4. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
